- **Play time:** play indoor and outdoor games with your child like ludo ,carom ,puzzles, and catch &throw the ball etc to instill discipline, generate sporting spirit, channelizing energies constructively.
- **Cleaniness:** Let your child be aware of cleaning and managing belonging and surroundings.
- visit to India gate /children's park /Nehru planetarium/ railway station.
- **Converse with your child in English :** Lets enhance the communication skills of children by using simple words phrases and sentences like –
 - I am feeling hungry/ thirsty
 - May I play with my toys
 - I have finished my work / food
 - Please trim my nails
 - Can I watch T.V

➤ Please give me a glass of water

ENGLISH:

Reading time – Do picture reading from “ FUN WITH ENGLISH “ book daily.

Show and tell : Ask your child to name the different things in the environment .For e.g. names of vehicles (car,bus) household things (chair,table,fan,cooler,fan etc.) things in the kitchen (spoon,cup,fork,match box etc.)Encourage your child to speak in a sentences as follows :

1 This is a car .

2 It is red in colour .

3 It has four wheels.

Rhyme time : Recite rhyme everyday from pg no - to of rhythmic rhyme book with voice modulation and actions and play rhythmic rhyme CD also.

Pattern writing : Help the child practice the following pattern in English drawing file.

Strokes:

- Do practice of recognizing numbers through remote, mobile and counting by going upstairs and downstairs.
- **Know your yourself** : Learn the following sentences related to “ Myself”

 - 2 I am a boy/girl .

- Let your child watch a cartoon film on T.V or any other programme of his/ her own choice . After he /she finishes watching the programme talk about it . Let your child be an active participant in conversation.
- Let your child sit with his/her eyes closed for 2 minutes and listen to different sounds .After 2 minutes ask your child to open his/ her eyes and quickly tell about the different sounds he / she has heard (e.g . barking of a dog ,chirping of birds , noise of an aeroplane etc) Now let your child to tell the sequence in which he / she heard the different sounds .
- **G.K. (Let's be creative)**
 - **Make cut out of one land transport , one air transport and one water transport e.g. car ,ship and aeroplane etc.**
 - **Make 2 cut outs of junk/healthy food, wild animal/domestic animal on A4 size sheet.**
 - **Make beautiful bird feeder .**
 - **Make a tablemat by using stickers of fruits and vegetables and laminate it and bring everyday in school.**
 - **Visit to India gate /children's park /Nehru planetarium/ railway station take atleast 4 photographs.**
 - **Number box :** Take a rectangular box and decorate it with finger printing /paper tearing / vegetable printing .Collect 1 bottle cap, 2 beads , and 3 buttons etc up to number 9 in rectangular box.
