

- 1. Read Chapters 1 and 2 and 4, learn the difficult words and write their meaning in the rough notebook.
- 2.Project: Create a Food Chain Model

Objective: Understand the concept of food chains and the relationships between different organisms.

Instructions:

- 1. Choose a specific ecosystem (e.g., forest, ocean, desert).
- 2. Research and identify different organisms (plants and animals) in the ecosystem.
- 3. Create a model or diagram showing the food chain relationships between the organisms.
- 4. Include arrows to show the flow of energy from one organism to another.
- 5. Label each organism as a producer (plant) or consumer (animal).

Example:

Grass (producer) \rightarrow Insect (primary consumer) \rightarrow Frog (secondary consumer) \rightarrow Snake (tertiary consumer) 3. Read newspapers, magazines etc. and collect six articles related to Forest. Paste them on A4 size sheet. (Maximum two article on one sheet)

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- 4. Collect six things we get from the forest and label them. (put it in a box)

- 5. Show the six stages of germination in a bean seed with the help of diagram .(use A4 size sheets to show each stage)
- 6. * Activity: Choose a specific forest in India (e.g., the Sunderbans, the Western Ghats, Gir Forest) or a type of forest (e.g., rainforests, deciduous forests).
- * Homework: Research interesting facts about your chosen forest or forest type. Find out about the plants, animals, and any unique features. Present your findings as a short written report with pictures.

Social Science

Option 1: Family & Migration Focus

- * **Project:** **"My Family's Story of Where We Belong"**
- * **Task:** Interview family members (parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles) to learn about where your family has lived over time. Create a visual presentation (like a scrapbook, a chart, or even a short video) showing the different places your family has called home. Include:
 - * Names of the places.
 - * Reasons for moving (if applicable).
 - * Something interesting or special about each place.
 - * Photos or drawings related to those places or family members.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This directly relates to understanding the importance of family support and appreciation, as well as exploring reasons for human migration.
- * **Activity:** **"Values We Inherit"**
- * **Task:** Think about the good qualities and values you have learned from your family. Choose 3-4 of these values and for each one, write a short paragraph explaining:
 - * What the value is.
 - * How you learned it from a family member (give a specific example).

- * Why this value is important to you.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This reinforces the appreciation of qualities passed down through family.
- **Option 2: Our Surroundings & Community Care Focus**
- * **Project:** **"Our Local Heroes: Caring for Our Neighborhood"**
- * **Task:** Observe your neighborhood or community. Identify people or groups who are actively involved in caring for the surroundings (e.g., keeping parks clean, helping the needy, organizing community events). Choose one or two such "local heroes" and:
- * Try to interview them (with adult supervision). Ask them about what they do and why it's important to them.
- * Create a poster or a short presentation showcasing their work and how it benefits the community.
- * Think about one small way you and your family could contribute to caring for your neighborhood.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This connects to understanding responsibility towards the community and caring for neighbors.
- * **Activity:** **"Disaster Preparedness at Home"**
- * **Task:** Discuss with your family what you should do in case of a natural disaster like an earthquake.
 - * Identify safe spots in your home.
 - * Locate emergency contact numbers and keep them in an easily accessible place.
- * Help your family put together a small emergency kit with essential items (water, first-aid, non-perishable food, torch).
- * Draw a plan of your house showing the safe spots and the location of the emergency kit.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This activity directly addresses learning about safety during natural disasters.

- **Option 3: Inclusive Society Focus**
- * **Project:** **"Celebrating Abilities"**
- * **Task:** Research or learn about individuals with physical challenges who have achieved great things in different fields (sports, arts, science, etc.).
 - * Choose one or two inspiring individuals.
- * Create a visual presentation (like a biography poster or a slideshow) highlighting their achievements and the challenges they might have overcome.
 - * Reflect on what you have learned about their strength and determination.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This directly relates to understanding the progress made in the field of science and technology for physically challenged children and appreciating their abilities.
- * **Activity:** **"Being a Good Friend"**
- * **Task:** Think about what it means to be a good friend to someone who might have a physical challenge. Write a short story or draw a comic strip showing a situation where you are interacting with a friend who has a physical challenge in a helpful and inclusive way. Focus on their abilities rather than their limitations.
- * **Learning Outcome Connection:** This encourages understanding and sensitivity towards physically challenged individuals.

- * Remember to be creative and put your own unique touch on your work.
- * Don't hesitate to ask your family members for help and information.
- * Present your work neatly and clearly.
